



## **Family Outreach Worker**

The Clear Hills Youth Treatment Centre is a distinctive healing and treatment program based on First Nation culture, ceremony, traditions, songs, and land-based teachings. The Clear Hills Youth Treatment Centre follows a wholistic, client-centered, needs-based approach, celebrating inclusion, identity and diversity. The Family & Outreach Worker provides non-judgmental support to families with a youth seeking treatment at the Clear Hills Youth Treatment Centre. This role will provide support to parents/caregivers to help improve family function and feel more secure and confident in their abilities. They will support families to connect to formal and informal resources in and around their community, build capacity in families to navigate systems, address challenges that the family may face, identify, and achieve the family's goals, assist in learning day to day life skills and youth/parenting skills, model professional behavior in working with other team members, who are connected and a part of the youth' treatment plan.
