



Youth Counsellor (4) Full-Time & (2) Part-Time

The Clear Hills Youth Treatment Centre (CHYTC) is a distinctive healing and treatment program based on First Nation culture, ceremony, traditions, songs, and land-based teachings. The Clear Hills Youth Treatment Centre follows a holistic, client-centered, needs-based approach, celebrating inclusion, identity, and diversity. The Youth Counsellor will support and advocate on behalf of youth facing addiction issues and seeking treatment at the Clear Hills Youth Treatment Centre. The Youth Counsellor may work with clients on an individual or group basis, offering practical and emotional support to move through the treatment program, helping them to develop skills to make positive changes in their lives, plan to address the issues young people face, including building self-esteem and confidence, family conflict, homelessness, drug and alcohol abuse, sex and relationships, education, and finding a job. The Youth Counsellor develops meaningful relationships because of the ongoing contact and, subsequently, are present to provide support when the youth need it. Additionally, they are the source for appropriate role modelling, general supervision, and management of behavior.
