Thank you for your March 11, 2022 letter, and for sharing a copy of the Tribal Chiefs Ventures Inc. report regarding the draft Kindergarten to Grade 6 (K-6) curriculum.

Alberta's government promised parents and students an updated curriculum with more emphasis on the literacy and numeracy learning foundations and outcomes students will need for success. The Government of Alberta also remains committed to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada's *Calls to Action*. This commitment ensures that future provincial curriculum will contain mandatory content that reflects diverse First Nations, Métis and Inuit perspectives and experiences. Over the past year, we have been listening to feedback from Albertans, education partners and piloting school authorities on the draft K-6 curriculum.

We are carefully considering this input to further revise all K-6 subjects prior to their implementation. The feedback that Tribal Chiefs Ventures Inc. has provided is invaluable, and I thank you and your organization for engaging with the community, and for taking the time to review the draft and provide input. I have forwarded your report to staff for their further consideration.

I appreciate the contributions Tribal Chiefs Ventures Inc. has made to curriculum development, and I commend you on your ongoing commitment to supporting student success.
